If ingested, symptoms, which may be delayed, may include nosebleed and bleeding gums. In severe cases, there may be bruising and blood present in the faeces and urine. Antidote: Vitamin K1 administered by medical/ veterinary personnel only. In case of: Dermal exposure, wash skin with water and then with water and soap. Eye exposure, rinse eyes with eye-rinse liquid or water, keep eye lids open for at least 10 minutes. Oral exposure, rinse mouth carefully with water.
