## PYRETHRUM DUST PRO

For professional use only.

For the control of flying and crawling insects such as flies, mosquitoes, ants, cockroaches, wasps, silverfish, fleas, beetles, woodlice, carpet beetles and moths such as clothes moths in public hygiene and domestic situations. Also for use on spiders. Not for use on clothing or human bedding.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** Apply with a bulb duster or dust gun into insect breeding sites and harbourages. Insert the nozzle well into harbourages and pump gently to minimise contamination. Apply at close spacings to ensure good distribution. Clear up any dust contaminating exposed surfaces. Apply in ducts using a motorised duster.

**FOR FOOD PREPARATION AND STORAGE/EATING AREAS:** Before use, remove all exposed foodstuffs, all dishes and utensils and cover places where food is prepared, eaten or stored. Remove or cover fish tanks. After use, thoroughly ventilate treated areas. Clean up thoroughly all areas before processing/serving resumes.
