PYRETHRUM FOG

For the control of flying insects including flies, mosquitoes, moths and wasps in domestic and commercial areas

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Apply fogging at a rate of one litre per 1200 cubic metres for small flying insects (e.g. Drosophila) and at a rate of one litre per 300 cubic metres for larger insects (e.g. moths and house flies). Commence fogging at furthest point from exit to ensure escape route is always clear.

FOR FOOD PREPARATION AND STORAGE/EATING AREAS: Before use, remove all exposed foodstuffs, all dishes and utensils and cover places where food is prepared, eaten or stored. Remove or cover fish tanks. After use, thoroughly ventilate treated areas. Clean up thoroughly all areas/ surfaces before processing/serving resumes.
